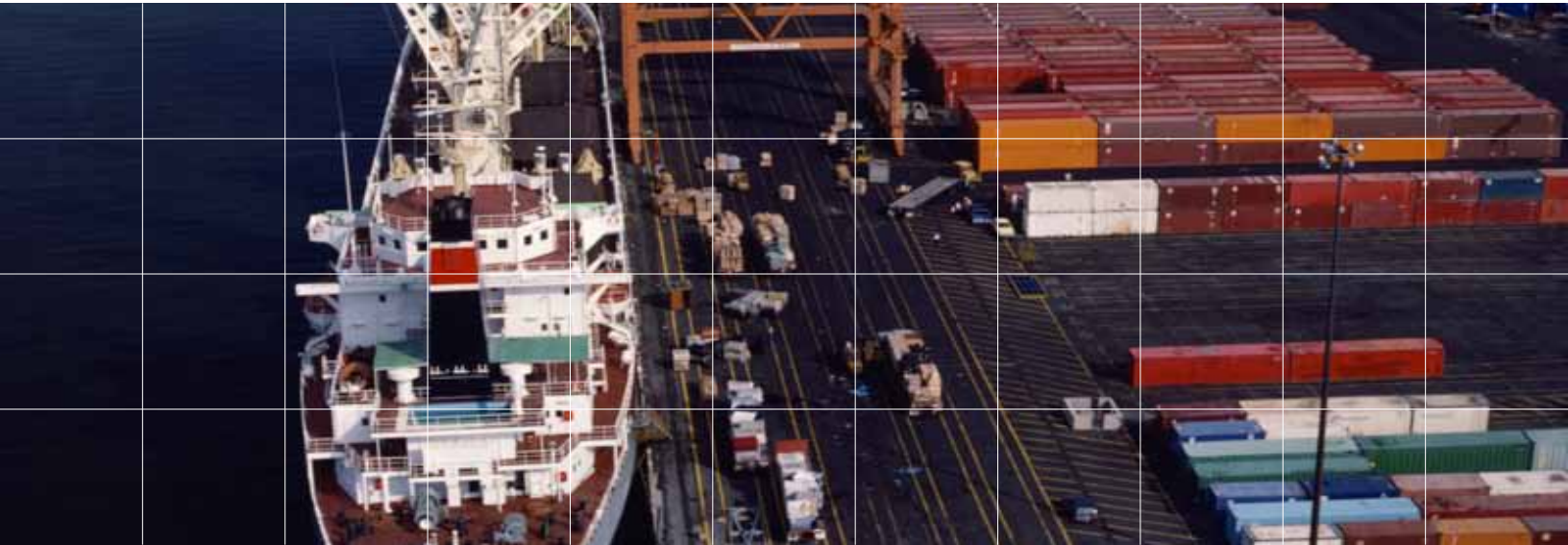

## THE INTERNATIONAL TRADE COMMISSION

### SECTION 337 PROCEEDINGS

Jones Day's ITC trial lawyers have represented both complainants and respondents in dozens of these extremely fast-paced cases from pre-filing investigation to discovery to trial to Customs proceedings to Appeals to the Federal Circuit. This experience allows Jones Day's lawyers to focus on preparing a case at the ITC without engaging in expensive, ineffective, and time-consuming distractions.

Any company in the world owning U.S. intellectual property and meeting the domestic industry requirement can stop infringement by suing under Section 337 of the U.S. trade laws at the ITC. It is important for respondents named in an ITC investigation to move quickly to hire seasoned ITC counsel to ensure that their interests are fully protected.

Once the ITC begins an investigation, infringers can lose their ability to sell in the U.S. within months. The Commission's orders on imported goods are enforced by U.S. Customs, and products found to be covered by the ITC's orders are impounded at the ports.

#### WHAT MAKES THE ITC UNIQUE?

**Speed.** Section 337 requires the Commission to decide the case at the "earliest practicable time." That can mean a trial just months after the complaint is filed.

**In Rem Jurisdiction.** The Commission's jurisdiction in Section 337 cases is over the imported articles. It does not depend upon the presence of the parties in the U.S.

**Powerful Remedies.** The Commission enters orders prohibiting entry of infringing products into the U.S. regardless of where the maker or the importer of such goods is located. These orders are enforced by Customs at ports of entry.

**Highly Specialized Agency.** The ITC staff attorneys and judges are very experienced in patent infringement litigation. The procedural rules are unique, making it important for any party to retain counsel with substantial experience in this forum.

**Downstream Relief.** The ITC has the authority to exclude goods that incorporate infringing products as components. This can have a profound impact on industries where finished products contain thousands of component parts.
