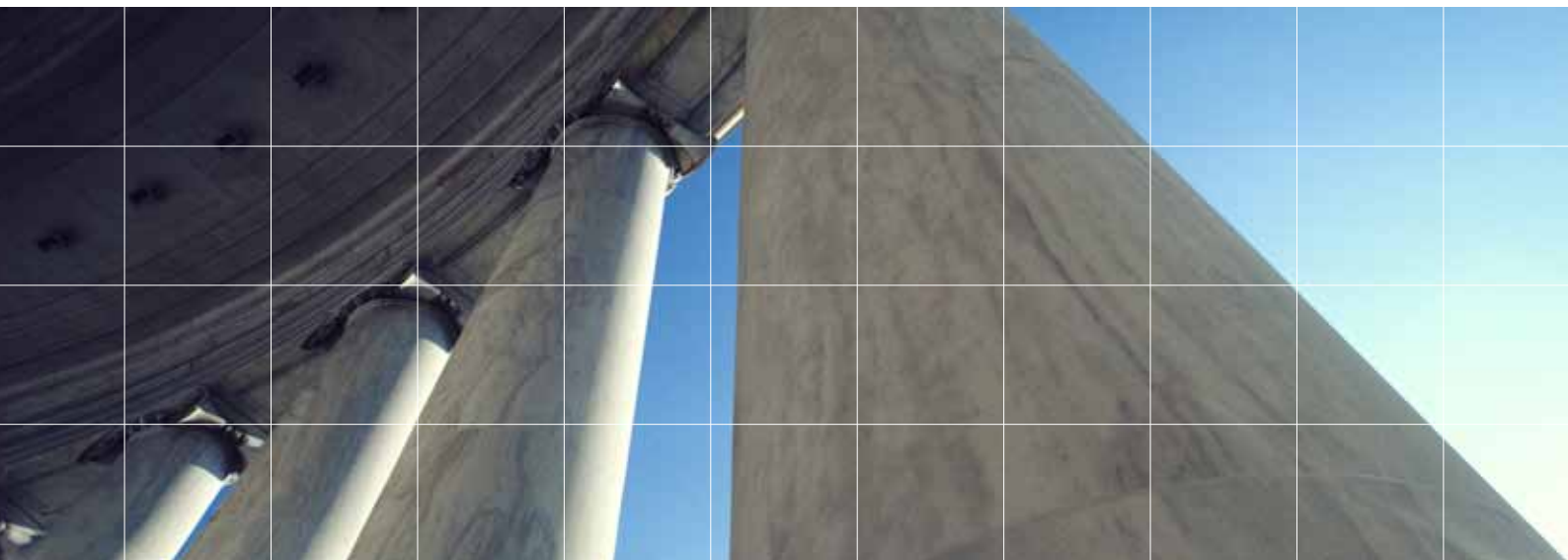

In Russia Jones Day has a proven track record acting on behalf of Russian and Western clients in a broad range of complex multijurisdictional disputes. Jones Day lawyers also have significant experience representing clients in Russian domestic litigation matters in state *arbitrazh* courts and courts of general jurisdiction, in such areas as banking, securities, corporate law, commercial matters, insurance, tax, competition, product liability, and employment. We also advise clients in various administrative proceedings, investigations, and corporate compliance matters. Selected recent representations are set out below.

TECHSNABEXPORT

Successfully represented Techsnabexport, a Russian state-owned company, as cocounsel in defense of a claim by Globe Nuclear Services and Supply for alleged lost profits amounting to almost US\$1 billion. Subsequently successfully defended against an attempt to set aside the award in the Svea Court of Appeals in Stockholm.

ARKHANGELSKOE GEOLOGODOBYCHNOE PREDPRIYATIE

Represented Arkhangelskoe Geologodobychnoe Predpriyatie, a subsidiary of LUKOIL, in an arbitration in Stockholm under UNCITRAL rules, brought by Archangel Diamond Corporation, a subsidiary of De Beers. The dispute concerned rights to a license to explore a diamond mine in Russia worth about US\$8 billion.

LUKOIL

Represented defendants LUKOIL and its various U.S. subsidiaries, including Getty Petroleum Marketing Inc., in a case resulting in the dismissal of claims of trademark infringement and unfair competition brought by the plaintiff.

ALFA-BANK AND ALFA CAPITAL MARKETS

Successfully represented defendants Alfa-Bank and Alfa Capital Markets in a case involving trademark infringement and unfair-competition claims in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York.

ROUST HOLDING LIMITED

Represented Roust Holding Limited (and its subsidiaries, including Russian Standard Bank) in a US\$350 million dispute with BNP Paribas and Cetelem over a failed consumer finance joint venture in Russia.

RUSSIAN COMPANY AND ITS PRINCIPAL

Represented a Russian company and its principal in an ICC arbitration regarding the alleged repudiation of a joint-venture agreement relating to the formation and management of a Russian insurance company. Specific performance of the agreement was claimed, alternatively, damages exceeding US\$250 million.

SIBIR ENERGY

Represented Sibir Energy, until recently the largest company on AIM by market capitalization, in connection with the fraud perpetrated by its directors, considered to be the second-largest fraud ever perpetrated against an AIM-listed company.

RUSSIAN-OWNED GROUP

Represented a major Russian-owned group in relation to a dispute regarding the exercise of a multimillion-euro share option in a publicly listed European company. In addition to instituting arbitration proceedings, the representation included successfully obtaining interim relief freezing the relevant shares (and voting rights thereunder).

THE CITY OF MOSCOW

Represented the City of Moscow and its affiliate OEK-Finance in the defense of a multibillion-dollar claim brought by, *inter alios*, a Russian businessman and politician, arising from a joint venture for the redevelopment of a landmark Moscow hotel complex.

SAP

Represented SAP in several litigation matters and administrative proceedings arising from a dispute with IKT CONSULT, which resulted in the dismissal of a €24 million claim against SAP, a judgment in favor of SAP in the amount of €5.5 million, and termination of an investigation of SAP by Russia's Federal Antimonopoly Service initiated by IKT CONSULT.

EUROCEMENT GROUP

Advised EUROCEMENT group in connection with the judicial review of a US\$70 million fine and restrictions on business imposed by Russia's Federal Antimonopoly Service.

ALFA CAPITAL MARKETS

Succeeded in obtaining the voluntary dismissal of RICO claims brought against Alfa Capital Markets (USA), Inc., by IPOC International Growth Fund in connection with its failed effort to acquire a stake in a Russian telecommunications company.
